

# COOKIE POLICY

## I. DEFINITIONS.

1. The Personal Data Administrator of the Website available at: <https://quick-app.eu/> hereinafter referred to as the **Website**, is **Quick Ride Sp. z o.o. Sp.k.** with its registered office in Gdynia, Władysława IV nr 43, 81-395 Gdynia, entered into the Register of Entrepreneurs of the National Court Register kept by the District Court Gdańsk-Północ in Gdańsk, VIII Economic Division of the National Court Register, under KRS number: 0000770206, NIP: 5862341500, REGON: 382511010, hereinafter referred to as **Personal Data Administrator**. 1. Cookies - IT data, small text files, recorded by websites you visit and stored on the Devices through which you use the Administrator's Website. The information contained in cookies is necessary for the website to function properly, while these files are encrypted to prevent them from being made available to unauthorised persons. The information collected in cookies can be read by the Administrator and its contractors (for technical reasons) .
2. Device - the electronic device through which you access the Administrator's website.
3. User - any person visiting the [www.quick-app.eu](http://www.quick-app.eu) website.
4. Website - [www.quick-app.eu](http://www.quick-app.eu) including subpages .

## II. USE OF COOKIES.

1. The administrator uses cookies via the website.
2. Cookies are only used within the scope of the User's consent.
3. Information collected from cookies is used for the proper optimisation of the website's operation, as well as for statistical purposes.
4. Cookies record a website user's activity by recognising the Device, so that the website is displayed in a way optimised to the individual user's preferences.
5. The solutions used on the website are safe for the Devices of Users using the Administrator's website. It is not possible for dangerous or malicious software to enter the Users' Devices.
6. The Administrator uses two types of cookies:
  - a) **Session cookies**: these are files that are stored on the User's Device and remain there until they leave the website or until the browser is closed. The stored information is then permanently deleted from the Device's memory. The mechanism of session cookies does not allow any personal data or any confidential information to be collected from the User's Device;
  - b) **Permanent cookies**: these are stored on the User's Device and remain there until they are deleted. Files of this type remain on the User's Device for the time specified in the file parameters or until they are manually deleted by the User. The end of the session of a particular browser or the switching off of the Device does not cause them to be deleted from the Device.

The mechanism of permanent Cookies does not allow any personal data or any confidential information to be collected from the User's Device.

7. With regard to the source of the Cookies data, the Administrator uses **its own Cookies**, i.e., files generated by the website and placed on it by the Administrator.
8. The cookies used must be classified as **technical/non-essential cookies**, i.e. cookies necessary to ensure the correct functioning of the website, including: to ensure the correct display of the website depending on the device used by the user or the settings of this device; to adapt the content on the website which is technically relevant to the functioning of the website (e.g. the language of the website); to remember whether the user has given his/her consent to the display of certain content.
9. You can delete cookies from your browser at any time and prevent them from being reinstalled .

### **III. MEANS OF DEFINING THE CONDITIONS FOR STORING OR ACCESSING COOKIES.**

1. The User has the possibility of limiting or disabling access to Cookies on their Device. If this option is used, the use of the Administrator's website will be possible, except for functions that by their nature require Cookies.
2. The User may independently and at any time change their cookie settings, specifying the conditions for storing and accessing cookies on the User's Device.
3. The User may change the settings referred to above by means of the settings of their Internet browser or by means of the configuration of the service. These settings can be changed, in particular, in such a way as to block the automatic handling of cookies in the settings of the Internet browser or inform on their placement on the Device each time. Detailed information on the possibility and methods of using cookies is available in the settings of your software (web browser). 4. The user can delete cookies at any time using the available functions in the web browser they are using.
5. Restricting the use of cookies may affect some of the functionality available on the Administrator's website.
